Anti Terrorist Combat



Terrorism is undoubtedly the most challenging enemy facing the world today. All modern societies have this common enemy which is increasingly spreading, invading, disrupting and destroying life.

Terrorism is no longer a targeted objective such as a person, organization, company etc. Instead, it is directed at everyone with no mercy and seeks to maximize its effect in order to force governments, companies, individuals to meet the terrorists' demands, recognition and ideology.

Terrorist groups, organizations and factions are extensively organized both domestically and internationally with strong financial backing that allows for the acquisition of weapons and lethal means to be implemented throughout the world. This is accompanied by training, strong motivation, and the selection of various types of methods in order to attain the objective (including suicide bombers, kidnapping, hostage, explosives etc.)

Condor offers a course in antiterrorist combat that is officially recognized by the Israeli Ministry of Defense. This course is designed for special task units and professional security personnel that wish to improve their operational means in neutralizing terrorist threats and attacks.

Condor has all the necessary facilities in order to instruct courses in Israel. These facilities include vast equipment, firing ranges, training camps, weapons, combat equipment, conference rooms, simulation centers, accommodation and all the logistical infrastructure required.

- Day/night combat

- Arresting techniques (criminal/terrorist)
- Advanced unarmed combat against armed attackers
- Covert operations
- Special high risk V.I.P. protection
- Hostage release operations (day/night) in buildings, vehicles, bus, train, plane, ship
- Car ambush techniques
- Foreign missions
- The use of professional equipment
- Surveillance methods
- Physical training specific to antiterrorist combat
- Combat simulations
- Professional conferences
- Visits to installations

Specific separate training is mandatory for:

- Snipers
- Explosives
- Bomb disposal

- Offensive and defensive driving
- Technical support unit
- Specific equipment
- Negotiations
- Heads of teams
- Specific tasks
