Combat Shooting

Throughout history, mankind has been subject to constant criminal and terrorist attacks inflicting violence on nations, governments, companies, institutions and citizens. These acts have been carried out with numerous types of weapons and with strong motivation to destroy life and cause irreversible moral, physical, social, political and economic damage. Consequently, law enforcement agencies have decided to implement weapons as part of their defensive security policies designed to neutralize such attacks.



Still, this has not overwhelmingly changed the failure to effectively prevent and deter such attacks. The facts can be attributed to a lack of professional combat shooting training specific to offensive and defensive tactics. Target shooting, or "illusionary combat shooting" is ineffective and should remain a sport rather than a combat system.

Condor offers a specialized course in realistic combat shooting that is officially recognized by the Israeli Ministry of Defense. This course is designed to teach participants combat shooting methods in different criminal and terrorist environments. Participants will effectively learn offensive and defensive methods of combat with different weapons.



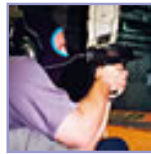
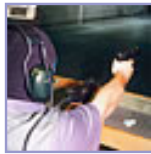
